Egnazia Vermouth Rosso Fact sheet

“A walk through Valle d’Itria’s natural pathways”

Its rust-like copper-colored body, is reflected in a delicate and sparkly green olive leaf.

Its complex perfume embodies the clean and distinctive scents of Apulian olive trees, thistles, local artichokes and bramble bushes bathed after a light summer rain. Immediate intense fruity notes are perceived, reminding of *sanguinella* orange, rhubarb, tangerine peel – after which senses move to a more herbal perfume such as mint, laurel, rosemary, thyme and faded lavender.

The taste is presented with character and elegance, enveloping the palate with a perfect balance between softness and freshness, taking advantage of all the mineral and limestone sensations of the Verdeca.

The citrus fruit of bitter orange scent comes back, mixed with resinous notes and iodate of the Adriatic sea breeze, moderated by a sustained and velvety alcoholic drape.

In the end, taste buds discover the exotic spice of pimento, coriander, myristica and bent, mirroring perfectly the typical Mediterranean vegetation of Valle d’Itria and its rural pathways made of dry stone walls, ancient olive trees and spontaneous vegetation.
